

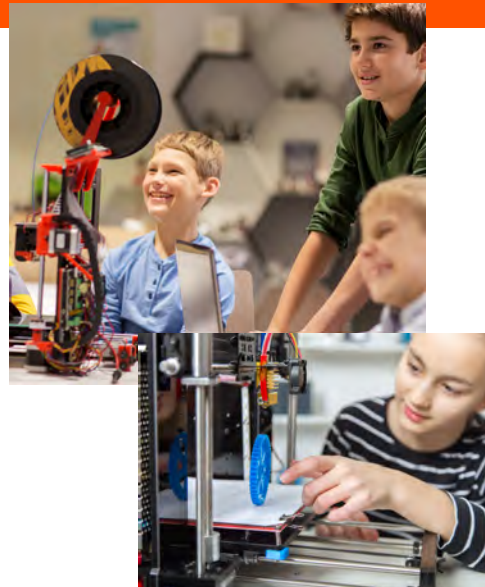
# STEAM

STEAM Saturdays is an out-of-school program designed to engage students in **Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math**. The goal is to inspire and encourage interest within our future generations in STEAM related skills and occupations by developing their 21<sup>st</sup> century skills such as advanced problem solving, collaboration and teamwork, creativity and imagination, and critical thinking.

Each Saturday session will engage students in a different STEAM topic: engineering and design thinking, robotics and computer coding, and making (creativity, invention, production). Students will be fully engaged in hands-on, interactive learning with the classrooms facilitated by Pennsylvania-certified teachers.
